

Ladies and Gentlemen the Committee would like to remind everyone of the following club rules:

- There is no practice for any competitor on the day of a club competition (other than a matchplay competition). Just to use an example. If a player plays a few holes on a Friday afternoon that player cannot then put in a card Friday evening in the Weekend competition. He/she can of course play the next day in the competition.

- If a player NR's during a competition they cannot play another round in that competition for the rest of the day. For example if a player NR's say halfway through a round then they should not play another hole in that competition for the rest of the day. This was a rule passed by members in a vote at an AGM a number of years ago. (The only exception to this rule is where a committee member is required to leave the course to deal with essential club business).

Also, as a matter of courtesy to the competition and the work of the competitions secretary, it would be appreciated if every player in the competition could put their card in the competitions box after they are finished. It doesnt matter if its good bad or indifferent. Dont be throwing them in the bin. It makes life easier when all the cards are returned for matching up with the competitions sheet and the records for the treasurer.
